Thank you to all who contribution to our Act of Remembrance 2024.

The weekend began with Poppies and Proms, with Burton Concert Band, with the church choir making a fitting contribution of three musical items.

A raffle was held and refreshments served and the evening raised £496.70, after expenses and a contribution to the British Legion.

Sunday Morning the weather was fair which helped tremendously for the parade, which led by a Piper, started from the Village, arriving at the War Memorial for the laying of wreaths, the Roll of Honour read, and the two minutes silence observed, before we went into the church, which had been beautifully decorated with flower displays by Terry Clarke and the Poppy Cascade fitted by the Scouts, led by the choir and the colour party. The service of Remembrance was well attended and enjoyed by both young and old. Thank you, Reverend Dave, for leading this service.

On Monday a group met at the Memorial at 11.00 am to again observe the two minutes silence and the names of the fallen read by George Brannan. A very successful and meaningful remembrance 2024. We were able to donate £600.00 from Tutbury to the Royal British Legion.

SATURDAY, 30th NOVEMBER starts our Christmas Season – with the Christmas Fayre. This will be held with an extended Priory Pantry, opening at 10.00 am until 2.00 pm.
